<b>METHOD OF TRANSPORT:</b>	<b>Students will be transported to the pools from school after roll call. The buses will be leaving THS at 9:00am. Students will be transported back to school from the pools at the conclusion of the event at 1:30pm, allowing students who normally catch a bus home from school to do so at 2:00pm.</b>
<b>FOOD:</b>	Canteen will be operational during the day. It is also recommended that students bring their own water bottles and food.
<b>DRESS CODE:</b>	Students can wear their school sports uniform + a T-Shirt that is the colour of their sporting house. It is recommended that students wear their swimming attire underneath their school sports uniform to prevent the amount of time spent in the change rooms on arrival to the venue. Swimming attire should consist of swimming clothing that is suitable for competitive swimming. Inappropriate swimwear as outlined by Speers Point Swim Centre includes: denim, cotton, leotards, bike pants, underwear, boxer shorts, t-shirts, polo's and singlets, street clothings, sport/gym clothes, footwear.
<b>EQUIPMENT REQUIRED:</b>	Swimming attire, swimming cap, swimming goggles, hat, towel, Sunscreen.
<b>EDUCATIONAL RATIONALE:</b>	Students to compete in swimming events showing proficiency in the swimming strokes and fundamentals of swimming.

**IMPORTANT INFORMATION: *Personal Injury Statement***

The NSW Supplementary Sporting Injury Benefits Scheme, funded by the NSW Government, provides limited cover for serious injury resulting in the permanent loss of a prescribed faculty or the loss of use of certain prescribed parts of the body.
