





BOUNDARY ADJUSTMENTS - COMMUNICATION MESSAGE

Dear Parents, Carers and School Community Members,

Following close consultation between the principals of Morisset High School, Toronto High School and Wangi Wangi Public School, stakeholder groups, our Director, Educational Leadership and the Department of Education's Service Planning division, through Schools Infrastructure NSW, changes have been made to the Toronto High School local intake area to include additional residential addresses.

These have been updated to cater for changing residential development patterns and to ensure the most efficient use of government school resources and permanent classroom accommodation.

As a result, Wangi Wangi Public School students who reside within the Wangi Wangi Public School intake area will now be considered to be eligible for local enrolment to Toronto High School. This change is effective from Term 2 2020 and is accessible on the NSW Public School Finder webpage at https://mv.education.nsw.gov.au/school-finder.

Please note, enrolment intake areas are subject to annual review.

Please see below for a map of the new enrolment intake areas for all three neighbouring schools (Morisset High School Toronto High School and Wangi Wangi Public School).

In accordance with the NSW Public School Finder tool, Year 6 students who have applied for non-local enrolment to Toronto High School for 2021 and who reside within the Wangi Wangi intake area will now be considered for local enrolment applications by Toronto High School. Wangi Wangi Public School will also be included in Toronto High School's Year 6 2020 to Year 7 2021 transition activities.

Changes to a local intake area might result in a family with a child/children currently enrolled and in attendance at Morisset High School as local students, consequently residing outside the local intake area. These families will retain the entitlement to enrol siblings at Morisset High School. (This does not apply to families with a child/children currently enrolled at the school as a non-local when the intake area was changed).

All principals were involved closely in considering this important change and are looking forward to working together into the future. Any enquiries regarding this transition or sibling attendance can be made with the relevant high school principal. All principals will warmly welcome any questions of clarification.


