- See the sights of Paris on foot and by river cruise.

Day 1: Depart Sydney.

Day 2: Arrive Rome. Meet your tour manager on arrival for a private coach transfer to the city centre. Enjoy an orientation walk before an early dinner. Overnight Rome.

Day 3: Classical Rome. A local expert guide will lead a tour through the Colosseum, Palatine Hill and Roman Forum. Marvel at the ancient Pantheon, the Baroque statues of Piazza Navona and throw a coin in the Trevi Fountain on a walking tour in the late afternoon. Overnight Rome.

Day 4: To the Bay of Naples. Travel by private coach to Naples. Take a tour of underground Naples. View the artworks and artefacts housed at the National Archaeological Museum with a local guide. Overnight Bay of Naples.

Day 5: Herculaneum and Vesuvius. Visit the excavations of the former resort town of Herculaneum, one of the so-called Cities of Vesuvius covered and preserved by the volcanic eruption of 79AD. In the afternoon, hike to the summit of Mount Vesuvius for a bird's eye view of the area (weather permitting). Overnight Bay of Naples.

Day 6: Pompeii and Sorrento. Today we undertake a detailed investigation of Pompeii. Explore the site with an expert local guide to see private and public buildings, bath complexes, daily life, economic activity, and evidence of the eruption. Spend the afternoon in the lovely seaside town of Sorrento. Overnight Bay of Naples.

Day 7: To Munich. Private coach transfer to the airport and fly to Germany. On arrival, take an orientation walk through the city centre and visit the Residenz museum. Overnight Munich.

Day 8: To Nuremberg. Travel to Dachau where a local guide will lead a visit of the concentration camp memorial site. Continue on private coach to the medieval walled town of Nuremberg. Explore the old town centre with your tour manager. Overnight Nuremberg.

Day 9: Rise and Fall of the Third Reich. Begin with a walking tour of the Rally Grounds, where millions of Nazi Party supporters gathered at the site for mass propaganda rallies in the 1930s. Explore the Documentation Centre with audio guides. Then, visit Memorium Nuremberg, home to Courtroom 600 which hosted the trials at the end of WWII. Overnight Nuremberg.

Day 10: To Paris. Private coach transfer to the airport for our flight to France. A sightseeing cruise along the Seine provides the perfect introduction to the City of Lights. Overnight Paris.

Day 11: Versailles. Travel to the nearby town of Versailles for a tour of its famous Chateau. There will also be time to wander the lovely gardens. Spend the afternoon in the bohemian quarter of Montmartre, visiting Sacre Coeur Cathedral and Artists Square. Overnight Paris.

Day 12: Disneyland. Spend the day at the happiest place on earth, Disneyland! Later in the afternoon, walk the Champs Elysees and ascend the Arc de Triomphe. Overnight Paris.

Day 13: Louvre and departure This morning, tour the highlights of the Musee de Louvre, including its most famous painting, the Mona Lisa. Private coach transfer to the airport for your return evening flight.

Day 14/15: Arrive Sydney.
